Symposium of Public Economics (SOPE) invites you to submit a paper for its 2021 online meeting on March 26 and 27, 2021. The purpose of the conference is to bring together the scholars of Public Economics to present and discuss their ongoing research. A selected number of young scholars, including graduate students, will be included in the program.

The conference invites submission of papers from all fields of public economics, including political economy and policy-oriented microeconomics. Preference will be given to complete papers. To be considered for the program, please submit your paper to Yukihiro Nishimura: ynishimu@econ.osaka-u.ac.jp, by Monday, February 1st, 2021.

SOPE is currently homed in Osaka University Japan. The first meeting took place in 2017, and the second in 2019. The past conferences had topical papers including tax administration, e-commerce tax, taxing multinational enterprises, and optimal taxation under performance-based contracts. In March 2020 we had a joint conference with BJPE (Belgian-Japanese Public Economics Workshop) at CORE in Belgium. This (March 2021) is the first time we are holding it online.
